

SPECIAL SESSION SYNOPSIS OF JULY 13, 2020

1. Under Board of Education:
 - a. Session resolved to temporarily closure of Preschool effective September 1, 2020.
 - b. Session resolved to continue Chinese Language School in September 2020, but reduce to only Saturday AM & PM sessions (no Friday and late Saturday PM for High School).

2. Under Worship Task Force (WTF):

Session received the WTF minutes of July 10, 2020 for information.

3. Session recognizes the selfless contribution of Andrew Wong (Chair of Transition Committee) during this time in preparing for the building demolition. Our Clerk will present a written thanks with appreciation.

4. The Clerk of Session Adrian and Elder George will arrange Trustees to sign of the Encroachment Agreements and related documents.

5. Session resolved that all mails will be re-directed to the home address of Rev Morgan during the period of transition. All mails (including mail-in donation) will be sorted out and managed by Rev Morgan and Treasury Linda respectively.

6. Under Mission Committee:

- a. Session agreed to raise \$4,500 CDN to support Joelle James for her 16 month missionary internship in southern France this fall through Adventic Cross Cultural Initiatives (ACCI). So far, we have received \$2,500. Anyone who would like to make a contribution should send your cheque to our church specify for Missions.
- b. Session agreed to support \$3,000 for Mustard Seed International for a teacher-in-training program in Indonesia.
- c. Session agreed to contribute \$3,500 to Chinese International Missions, Canada (CIM) to support a school teacher salary for 3 months in a village school project in Ghana, Africa.
- d. Session agreed to fund for a lecture series offered by the Centre of Missional Leadership in St. Andrew's Hall. It commences in Sept. 2020 with 6 sessions in the first year, on the last Saturday of each month (Except December).
- e. Elder Tim Tam will contact the CPC Board of Education with a view to collaboration with the Preschool and Chinese Language School.
- f. In order to promote missions within our congregations, it is suggested that Pastor Morgan to have Mission Sundays in both English and Chinese worship services on our current mission projects. E.G. Joelle's video clip of her mission internship, Mustard Seed photos of the teacher-in-training project, and Chinese international Missions photos of Ghana village teacher.
